Stephen Flynn, Senior Management Analyst, provided a brief overview of the staff report and reviewed the changes incorporated into the CWC Annual Report. Mr. Flynn thanked Vice Chairperson Fredlund for her hard work and collaboration.

Members of the Committee discussed and made the following comments/requests: 1) Referenced Attachment B, Summary Report on Benefits and Key Achievements, under Caltrain Service Upgrades and suggested removing geographic references so the report reads: Electrifying the Caltrain system will increase speed; 2) requested the following words in the last line of Attachment B, Summary Report on Benefits and Key Achievements, under Caltrain Service Upgrades be stricken: “Caltrain expects to begin rollout of electrified passenger service in winter 2020”; and 3) Referenced Attachment C, Comprehensive Annual Report and noted verbiage is missing at the end of the third paragraph.

**M/S/C (Tebo/O’Connor)** to approve the format and content of Attachments A, B, and C, **as amended** with the recommendation to strike the words in Attachment B “from Palo Alto to Gilroy” in the first sentence under Caltrain Service Upgrades, also to strike the words “Caltrain expects to begin rollout of electrified passenger service in winter 2020” in the last sentence, and; and to add in missing verbiage in Attachment C.

**13.** Legislative Update Matrix

Kurt Evans, Government Affairs Manager, provided a verbal report, highlighting the following: 1) Passage of Assembly Bill (AB) 398 (E. Garcia), Cap-and-Trade; 2) update on Regional Measure 3 - Senate Bill (SB) 595 (Beall), and; 3) introduction of SB 797 (Hill), Caltrain Dedicated Revenue Source.

Members of the Committee congratulated and thanked Mr. Evans for his exemplary public service. Discussion ensued regarding the following: 1) potential regional Caltrain tax measure; 2) cap-and-trade expectations; and 3) consolidation of Bay Area transit agencies. There was general support for a specified funding source for Caltrain, noting it has been difficult for local jurisdictions to fund Caltrain operations.

Jane Shinn, Senior Management Analyst, provided a brief verbal report, highlighting the following: 1) Bicycle & Pedestrian Program Category Competitive Grants; 2) Highway Interchange Program Category, and; 3) Next Steps.

Members of the Committee discussed the following: 1) board deferral of guidelines; 2) 2016 Measure A litigation, and; 3) proposed Capital Project Competitive Grant Program.

Vice Chairperson Fredlund announced VTA Board Workshops are scheduled for Friday, August 25, 2017, and Friday, September 22, 2017, both at 9:00 a.m., where VTA's BART Silicon Valley Phase II construction methodology (single/twin bore) will be discussed.

Member Rogers announced the Caltrain service to the Garlic Festival was a huge success. The event was well attended.

Upon inquiry of Committee Members, staff indicated that VTA has a Land Use and Transportation Integration Team that will examine the potential impacts of the proposed new Google development in Downtown San Jose. Members of the Committee commented San Jose Airport is experimenting with driverless shuttles and noted the importance of the People Mover connection from the San Jose Airport to local stadium venues. Staff indicated the Quarterly Development Report will address these important issues.

Vice Chairperson Fredlund encouraged Committee Members to attend the San Jose Jazz Festival on Sunday, August 13, 2017, noting her husband's Big Band performance would begin at 5:00 p.m.
